Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy are based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who wrote a diary recording the revelations she received about God’s mercy. The message is that God loves us – all of us – no matter how great our sins. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. It is a message as simple as ABC. A: ask for his mercy. B: be merciful. C: completely trust in Jesus.

St. Casimir’s Church in Endicott will celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday today at 3:00 pm. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be recited before Mass. Individual and group prayers for healing will be offered, and Charlie Hunt will bring the relic of Padre Pio for individual pray-overs.
