Easter Duty: All the faithful are bound by obligation to receive Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. This obligation may be fulfilled between February 21 (First Sunday in Lent) and May 30 (Trinity Sunday). Catholics are also bound by obligation to faithfully confess serious sin at least once a year (Canon 989).
