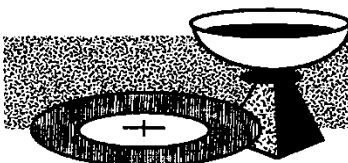



Dear Friends,

It has been 41 years since our church was built and it has held up well. After 41 years we do need to replace the shingles on the south side. We have seen the wood shingles gradually fall off and there is a danger of leakage if we wait longer to replace them.

So here's the program: for \$16,000 we can replace them with vinyl shake shingles. They will look like wood but are really vinyl.

Because of your consistent support, we are in a position to take care of this cost. Thank you for making that possible. The work should be done during July.

Our Super Money Raffle tickets sales are coming in slowly. Last year, we sold 700 tickets. Our goal is to sell all 1,000 tickets this year.
