

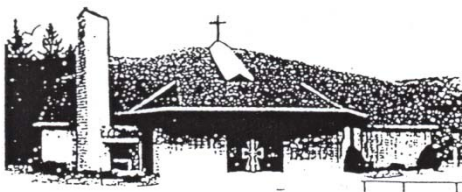

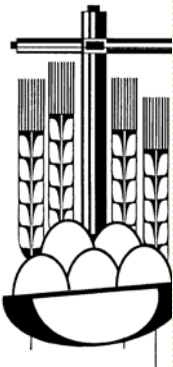

John Dubay, LMFT, an experienced Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, will speak at all Masses next weekend. In addition, he will present a Marriage Enhancement Program at our Parish.
